A northward relocation and centralization of the security checkpoint in Concourse B has been planned, which will enable to establish airside connections between Concourses A, B and C to become an Airside Center for better inhabitation. New efficient smart security layouts have been incorporated in the design.

- Adaptation of the security area plans involving all terminal levels
- Flow plan development (for passenger, PRM, staff, supply and disposal flows)
