Concept study for re-configuration of Terminal 1 Concourse B with new central security, relocated border control and transfer checkpoints, optimized passenger flows, an enlarged Non-Schengen market place and re-configured airside connection between the Concourses A, B and C.

The scope of this project also included the integration of the existing APM system (automated people mover) between Terminal 1 and 2 with major reconfiguration of various stations.

- Planning of a phased development of concourse B
