

Terminal Master Planning

Hamburg International Airport has started a Master Planning process for its Terminal Buildings involving all departments of the Airport. Based on a new traffic forecast for the year 2035 and the previously determined concepts for the Airside consolidated layouts have been developed and suggested to the board.

Services

- Determination of capacity requirements for major parts of the terminal through simulation
- Development and evaluation of 3 basic concepts for the airside concourse area including a central market place, pier expansions and a separate Non-Schengen level
- Analysis and optimization of the passenger flows for all options
- Layout options for check-in areas and security checkpoints
- Coordination of a working group on passenger flows and functions
- Review of the consolidated plans and reports
